

VANISHING VOLVO

WITH REFERENCE to the Volvo 122S B20 Road Test that was published in the November issue of CAR, we would like to draw your attention to the fact that the 122S will not continue in South Africa indefinitely as an assembled model. In fact the 122S has been dropped from all Volvo markets throughout the world with the exception of South Africa, but once the present supply of



C.K.D. kits is exhausted there will be no further 122S models available.

South Africa is rather unique in this aspect in that the last Volvo 122S to be produced in the world will be produced in the Republic of South Africa. We expected production to cease at the end of 1970 or early in 1971, depending on demand.

Another point we would like to make is that the photograph published is of a four-door model which has not been available in this country for some years, and the car tested by you must in fact have been a two-door machine. We appreciate that you were unable to photograph the actual test car because of weather conditions, but we would like to draw your attention to the fact that only the two door model is presently available.
